Your First Morning in Town

Three welcoming stops to help you find your way.

If this is your first visit, begin in the heart of town. These three stops will introduce you to Sarandipity, help you get your bearings, and make sure you know where to find both assistance and a few neighbor-only surprises.

1 Town Square

Pause beneath the Great Oak, check the Bulletin Board, see what is happening at the Gazebo, and get your first glimpse of the roads leading into each neighborhood.

THERE'S NO WRONG WAY TO EXPLORE

Follow the suggested route, choose your own path, or change direction whenever something catches your attention.

KEEP AN EYE OUT

Keys, signs, ordinary-looking objects, and hidden links may lead to unexpected discoveries around town.

THE TOWN IS ALWAYS GROWING

New buildings, resources, events, and pathways will appear as more corners of Sarandipity open to visitors.

Every part of town has its own personality and purpose.

Sarandipity's neighborhoods bring related shops, resources, gathering places, and experiences together. Use this overview to choose the part of town that best fits what you need—or simply start with the one that sounds most interesting.

Town Square & Civic District

The heart of Sarandipity, where visitors arrive, neighbors gather, and essential town services keep everyone informed and connected.

Main Street

Welcoming storefronts filled with practical resources for food, home, family life, planning, reading, and everyday needs.

EVERYDAY ESSENTIALS

Artisan Row

Creative studios and workshops for makers, writers, designers, paper lovers, and anyone inspired to create something meaningful.

MAKE SOMETHING

Schoolhouse Hill

Learning resources, children's activities, books, educational tools, faith-centered support, and places built to encourage curiosity.

LEARN & GROW

Heritage Hollow

Traditions, gardening, practical living, seasonal rhythms, homemade wisdom, and resources for tending what matters.

ROOTED LIVING

Willow Way

Quiet places for wellness, reflection, encouragement, remembrance, and finding a little breathing room during demanding seasons.

REST & RESTORE

Some neighborhoods are still growing. If you find a road under construction, consider it a promise that something new is on the way.

Around town, ordinary objects sometimes have more to say.

An ordinary Bulletin Board may hold a new collaboration, author visit, community announcement, sale, or reminder meant for Gazette subscribers.

A small object may lead to a freebie. A familiar portrait may hide a key. A door may open only during a particular event. Some pages are public; others are discovered through clues, purchases, passwords, or wonderfully nosy behavior.

These hidden corners are bonuses, not requirements. You can enjoy Sarandipity without finding every secret—but curious neighbors may discover a little more.

3 OPEN THE INFORMATION STAND

Find the Town Map, Visitor's Guide, Guided Tours, and Town Directory.

4 CHECK THE BULLETIN BOARD

See the latest town news, events, sales, and collaborations.

5 SUBSCRIBE TO THE GAZETTE

Receive town news, special deliveries, and updates by email.

6 COLLECT YOUR NEIGHBOR PASSPORT

Begin tracking your visits and discoveries when Passports become available.

7 CHOOSE A NEIGHBORHOOD

Follow one road and see where your curiosity takes you.

8 COME BACK AGAIN

Sarandipity is still growing, and something new may be waiting next time.
